The American Dental Association and New York Dental Society have asked dental offices to close their practice's for a three-week period. Drs. Girardi, Agnetta and Virga strongly agree and feel it is prudent to close our office for the recommended 3 weeks to preserve the safety of our team members, patients, and community. Additionally, due to the personal protective equipment restrictions (N95 masks, gowns, and face masks) placed even on emergent treatment during the COVID-19 outbreak, the CDC severely limits our ability to treat emergencies as we typically would.
